



Accreditation Status: National, Regional, State in Place

The University of Saint Joseph School of Pharmacy and Physician Assistant Studies' Doctor of Pharmacy program is accredited through 2030 by the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education, 190 S. The University of Saint Joseph is fully accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC).

The School of Pharmacy and Physician Assistant Studies and the Doctor of Pharmacy Program are fully accredited by the State of Connecticut.

On-time Graduation Rates (Class of 2023): 78.2%

Our tenth class graduated in May 2023. For this class, 78.2% of the entering cohort graduated on time. All ten of those who did not graduate on time remain with the program, extending their term of study for various reasons.

First-time NAPLEX Passing Rate (Class of 2022): 79.6%

Of the 2022 graduates who have taken the NAPLEX, 79.6% passed on their first attempt. The 2020 full-year first time pass rate was 72%. The Class of 2021 first-time pass rate was 72.7%.

Student Retention Rates (as of June 2023): 96.43%

Of the 112 students who entered with the current P1, P2, and P3 cohorts, three left the program and one was dismissed, leading to an overall retention rate of 96.43%.

Graduates with Fellowships and Residencies

In 2023, 9 of our 2023 graduates went on to a PGY-1 residency. This represents 82% of the 11 students who sought them, not including additional fellowships.

Community Service Hours Completed:

Each Pharmacy student completes at least 20 hours of community service annually. The Class of 2023 and the current cohorts (Classes of 2022-2024) have completed over 1200 of service as of June 9, 2023
