- PA Students have electronic access to many required texts provided by the University. Approximate purchase price of all required hard-copy textbooks (because electronic access is not available) and learning material subscriptions is approximately \$3000, which will be paid by the student directly to outside vendors and/or to the University during the didactic and clinical portions of the program.
- In addition to required equipment noted above, all students must have a Wi-Fi enabled personal laptop (NOT an iPad) that meets the specifications provided by the program. Matriculating students should consult the program before procuring a computer, to ensure compatibility with the various platforms utilized during their time in the PA Studies program.
- Cost of clinical travel is an estimate, and may differ for each student.
- Costs of living, such as room and board, are not included in the cost of attendance and will vary for each student.
- Health insurance is required for each student while enrolled in the program, is not included in the cost of attendance, and is not provided by the University.
