



Mission Integration Council

Charge

The Mission Integration Council reports to the President of the University and the Chair of the Board of Trustees and is charged with:

1. Identifying policies and procedures at USJ that ensure the continued integration of the University's mission and Catholic and Mercy Identities. The Council will assess policies and procedures related to:
 - a) Curricular and co-curricular development and integration;
 - b) Hiring, orientation, onboarding, and ongoing mission development of faculty, staff and Trustees;
 - c) Space, art, symbolism, and environment;
 - d) Inclusive worship, reflection, and ritual;
 - e) Engagement in community and celebrations; and
 - f) Catholic social teaching and critical concerns in action.
2. Evaluating how effective current policies and procedures are, and will continue to be, in ensuring mission integration.
3. Making recommendations for changes in policies and procedures to promote greater or more effective mission integration.
4. Making an annual presentation to the Board of Trustees to report on its evaluation and recommendations.

The Mission Integration Council is composed of:

- Two faculty members with doctorates in Theology or Religion
- One Sister of Mercy who is a USJ faculty or staff member
- Director of Campus Ministry
- One member of the Board of Trustees
