



NURSING AND ALLIED HEALTH STUDENTS

Does not apply to first year nursing students. Applies to all other undergraduate and graduate nursing students.

Current program requirements supersede those listed below and are subject to change.

REQUIREMENT	REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION
myHealth forms	- Required Immunization Form with supporting documentation - Tuberculosis (TB) Screening Questionnaire - Health History Form If ≥ age 18: Consent for Care & Emergency Contact Form OR If < age 18: Permission to Treat Form – this form MUST BE PRINTED and is available to print on the landing page of myHealth under the Printable Forms section (optional) Physical Exam Form (optional) TB Screening and Testing Form NOTE: Optional forms are available to print on the landing page of myHealth under the Printable Forms section
measles (rubeola), mumps, & rubella	Two doses of MMR vaccine or equivalent, given ≥ 28 days apart, with the first dose given no earlier than at 12 months of age, OR positive quantitative titers with lab results to measles, mumps, and rubella NOTES: Titers should be dated within three years of entry; most students born prior to 1/1/1957 are exempt from this requirement, but no date of birth exemptions are allowed for students in Nursing, School of Pharmacy, or Physician Assistant Studies
varicella (chicken pox)	Two doses of varicella vaccine or equivalent, given ≥ 28 days apart, with the first dose given no earlier than at 12 months of age, OR positive quantitative titer with lab result, OR provider-documented history of disease with date* NOTES: Titer should be dated within three years of entry; most students born prior to 1/1/1980 are exempt from this requirement, but no date of birth exemptions are allowed for students in Nursing, School of Pharmacy, or Physician Assistant Studies; *a positive titer is also required for students in Nursing, School of Pharmacy, or Physician Assistant Studies
hepatitis B	Complete vaccine series (2 or 3 doses by vaccine) OR positive quantitative surface antibody (anti-HBs) titer with lab result NOTE: Titer should be dated within three years of entry
meningococcal ACWY	IF LIVING IN UNIVERSITY HOUSING: One dose of meningococcal ACWY vaccine given within the five years prior to housing entry
tetanus, diphtheria, & pertussis (must remain up to date)	One Tdap dose within the past 10 years, given ≥ 18 years of age, with boosters required every 10 years NOTE: Td vaccination is not an acceptable substitute
seasonal influenza (annual requirement)	Current vaccination upon entry and then annually thereafter
COVID-19	Students are encouraged to check with their program directly to determine if this vaccination is required by their clinical site(s)
tuberculosis (TB) screening (annual requirement)	Two-Step PPD consisting of two separate skin tests with the second administered 7-21 days after the first one was read; this entails a total of four medical appointments, OR T-spot / QuantiFERON-TB (screening blood tests) NOTES: Additional documentation may be required if you have a history of a positive screening and/or have been treated for latent or active tuberculosis
physical exam (biennial requirement)	Physical exam within one year of entry and then every two years thereafter
additional documentation	As determined by the program
