measles (rubeola), mumps, & rubella	Two doses of MMR vaccine or equivalent, given ≥ 28 days apart, with the first dose given no earlier than at 12 months of age, AND positive quantitative titers with lab results to measles, mumps, and rubella NOTE: Titers should be dated within three years of entry
varicella (chicken pox)	Two doses of varicella vaccine or equivalent, given ≥ 28 days apart, with the first dose given no earlier than at 12 months of age, AND positive quantitative titer with lab result NOTE: Titer should be dated within three years of entry
hepatitis B	Complete vaccine series (2 or 3 doses by vaccine) AND positive quantitative surface antibody (anti-HBs) titer with lab result NOTE: Titer should be dated within three years of entry
meningococcal ACWY	IF LIVING IN UNIVERSITY HOUSING: One dose of meningococcal ACWY vaccine given within the five years prior to housing entry
tetanus, diphtheria, & pertussis (<i>must remain up to date</i>)	Completion of childhood DTaP series AND One Tdap dose within the past 10 years, given ≥ 18 years of age, with boosters required every 10 years NOTE: Td vaccination is not an acceptable substitute
seasonal influenza (<i>annual requirement</i>)	Current vaccination upon entry and then annually thereafter
COVID-19*	Recommended (<i>see comment</i>)
tuberculosis (TB) screening (<i>annual requirement</i>)	QuantiFERON-TB Gold / Plus (QFT or QFT-Plus), upon entry, and then annually thereafter NOTES: PPD/TST and T-spot are not acceptable substitutes; additional documentation may be required if you have a history of a positive screening and/or have been treated for latent or active tuberculosis
physical exam* (<i>biennial requirement</i>)	Physical exam within one year of entry and then every two years thereafter (<i>see comment</i>)
additional documentation	As determined by the program
<i>* Annual physical exam and/or COVID-19 vaccination may be required, depending on clinical placement</i>
