- All costs are estimates and subject to change.
- Tuition is adjusted on a per cohort basis.
- PA Students have electronic access to many required texts provided by the University. Textbook/Resources/Equipment costs listed above assume students utilize electronic access offered by the program. Approximate purchase price of all required hard-copy textbooks (because electronic access is not available) and learning resources cost is approximately \$2800, which will be paid by the student directly to outside vendors and/or to the University as instructed during the didactic and clinical portions of the program.
- PA students are required to complete a background check and drug screen at least twice during the program. Estimated cost included in the Textbook/Resources/Equipment listed above.
- In addition to required equipment noted above, all students must have a Wi-Fi enabled personal laptop (NOT an iPad) that meets the specifications provided by the program. Matriculating students should consult the program before procuring a computer, to ensure compatibility with the various platforms utilized during their time in the PA Studies program.
- Cost of clinical travel is an estimate, and may differ for each student.
- Costs of living, such as food and personal expenses (clothing, utilities, etc.), are not included in the cost of attendance and will vary for each student.
- Health insurance is required for each student while enrolled in the program and is not provided by the University.
